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## Policies, Terms, & Conditions

Reservations for banquets or special events, requires a minimum guest count of 12 or more. Any party smaller than 12 guests is welcome (and encouraged!) to join us in Bistro Perrier for regular scheduled dining services, Tuesday-Saturday, while classes are in session.

Banquets are booked and detailed by our Event Team. A member of the team can be reached directly at (267) 295-2385 or through our reservations desk at (215) 222-4200.

To secure reservations for a private event, WHC requires guest count & menu finalization, one month prior to the date of the scheduled event. This will ensure that our students are prepared properly, as they adhere to a strict curriculum & class schedules.



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Room rentals vary by dining experience.

If a full rental of the Bistro is required, 50% of the estimated total bill will be charged in addition to the room rental fee, two weeks prior to the date of the event. Contract signatures are also required 2 weeks prior to the event.

Deposits are non-refundable for events that are cancelled within two weeks of the date of the event.

Menu prices do not include tax and service charges:

- 8% sales tax on food
- 10% sales tax on alcoholic beverages
- 18% service charge

Outside food & beverage is strictly prohibited.

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## Styles of Service

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### -food-

Walnut Hill College offers a variety of service styles, that can be customized to suit any gathering. Styles of service can be combined with one another for select events. Certain styles may or may not be offered, subject to student classes. Prices vary per food & beverage selections.

### Plated Prix Fixe

A 3-course meal, appetizer, entrée and dessert, served individually to guests, seated at tables. Students take orders of appetizer and entrée choices. Flat rate pricing and menu selections are set prior to event.

### Reception

'Meet and Greet' style, guests can mingle and socialize while our students butler-serve hors d'oeuvres and craft signature cocktails. Receptions are often a great segue into a formal dinner.

## -food-

### Buffets & Stations

Appetizers, Entrees, and Desserts are displayed for self-service with a variety of menu options. Buffets can be a combination of stationary offerings, as well as student-chef attended action stations.

### Family Style

A great way to welcome anyone to our WHC family! Larger platters of menu items are set directly on each table. Students attend to the dining room, while guests self-serve from their own table.



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## Styles of Service

### -beverage-

#### Host Bar

Full Bar available

Wine, Beer, Cordials, Spirits,  
& Student-Crafted Cocktails

A tab is opened at the beginning of the event. Tab runs through the duration of the host's preferred time frame. Host settles the final bill at the end of the event, based on guest consumption of alcoholic beverages.

#### Drink Tickets

Equivalent to one alcoholic beverage. 1:1

The host of the event, agrees upon pays for, a set number of tickets per guest, prior to the event. \$10/ticket - issued by a member of WHC team, upon guest arrival. Tickets are collected by our student bartenders when alcoholic beverage is rendered.
